

What is a Teleclass?

It's **simply a phone call** that connects participants for a continuing education class without the inconvenience, time, or expense of traveling to a central site.

How Does It Work?

Before the teleclass you will receive an email or fax with the toll-free phone number and class handouts. On the scheduled date and time of you dial into the teleclass line.

How Will I Receive my Certificate of Completion?

Certificates of Completion are **emailed** or mailed.

NO partial hours are given for teleclasses. Participants must complete BOTH days for those classes that are scheduled for 2 days.

Cancellation Policy

A refund minus \$25 handling fee, or credit for a future seminar, may be issued if cancellation is 7 days prior to the teleclass date.

Replacement Certificates

Requests for replacement certificates or verification of attendance must be made in writing. Requests will be processed within 14 days. There is a \$25 fee for replacement certificates or to verify attendance at a seminar.
